

Escalade Trad Annot

Secteur Chambre du Roi - NEW ROUTES

Access:

Access the chimney behind the route "Fissure du Trou du Cul" (route 'K' in the guidebook), climb the boulders with iron pins while keeping right until you arrive on the chock stones above the entrance of the 'Chambre du Roi'. Here you find multiple bolts, watch out because they don't look very solid, I didn't place them. Both routes start from the same place as indicated in the picture. Although I cleaned the routes still be very careful with loose stones and dropping gear because the footpath is directly below the routes!!

"Tiroir de la Reine" 7a

Follow the obvious line of pockets that traverses to the right of the wall until you reach a perfect vertical finger splitter. Climb the finger splitter and watch out you don't use the loose block above and to the left of the crack next to a small bush, in other words 'Keep jamming and don't cheat'. Then you gain an orange coloured slab with a tricky move, then climb through the small overhang with dark coloured blocks. Then climb the crux through the layback / undercling crack and top out on the right hand side of the wall. Belay from the trees on top.

Recommended rack: Double rope BD # .4 (3x), .5, .75 (2x), 1, 3, 4

"King Bowie" 6c (?)

Use the same start as Tiroir de la Reine and just follow the obvious flake straight up past a small tree/shrub. Climb the next flake and place some extra gear before you run it out through the crux consisting of a funky move to access the next crack system to the right. Here climb under the triangular roof and exit to the left. (straight up is also possible but probably a bit harder). Belay from a crack on top (belay takes BD #2 and 3). I climbed it only on top-rope with cold and windy weather, so the grade may be different as mentioned above.
